People — demographics & education

In the 2011 Census, there were 10,748 people in Bondi Beach (State Suburbs) of these 51.5% were male and 48.5% were female. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people made up 0.4% of the population (46 people).

The median age of people in Bondi Beach (State Suburbs) was 33 years. Children aged 0 - 14 years made up 10.8% of the population and people aged 65 years and over made up 7.8% of the population.

Of people in Bondi Beach aged 15 years and over, 25.2% were married and 9.6% were either divorced or separated.

In Bondi Beach, of people aged 15 years and over, 26.0% of people were in a registered marriage and 21.0% were in a de facto marriage.

The median age of people in a registered marriage in Bondi Beach was 42 years, the median age of people in a de facto marriage was 32 years and the median age of people never married was 30 years.

In Bondi Beach, 28.9% of people were attending an educational institution. Of these, 10.2% were in primary school, 6.9% in secondary school and 25.6% in a tertiary or technical institution.

Families — family composition

Of the families in Bondi Beach, 30.9% were couple families with children, 54.7% were couple families without children and 11.6% were one parent families.

In Bondi Beach 20.8% of single parents were male and 79.2% were female.

People — cultural & language diversity

The most common ancestries in Bondi Beach were English 22.8%, Australian 14.8%, Irish 10.3%, Scottish 5.8% and German 3.4%.

In Bondi Beach 47.3% of people were born in Australia. The most common countries of birth were England 9.0%, New Zealand 4.3%, Ireland 2.5%, South Africa 2.2% and United States of America 1.5%.

In Bondi Beach, 31.7% of people had both parents born in Australia and 53.3% of people had both parents born overseas.

The most common responses for religion in Bondi Beach were No Religion 31.1%, Catholic 22.0%, Anglican 11.0%, Judaism 8.0% and Eastern Orthodox 2.4%.

In Bondi Beach, 68.7% of people only spoke English at home. Other languages spoken at home included Russian 2.2%, Spanish 2.0%, French 1.8%, German 1.5% and Italian 1.4%.

People — employment

There were 6,773 people who reported being in the labour force in the week before Census night in Bondi Beach. Of these 70.3% were employed full time, 20.8% were employed part-time and 4.4% were unemployed.

Of employed people in Bondi Beach, 6.0% worked 1 to 15 hours, 7.8% worked 16 to 24 hours and 60.8% worked 40 hours or more.

The most common occupations in Bondi Beach included Professionals 39.2%, Managers 17.8%, Clerical and Administrative Workers 10.6%, Community and Personal Service Workers 8.8%, and Technicians and Trades Workers 8.1%.

Of the employed people in Bondi Beach, 5.0% worked in Cafes, Restaurants and Takeaway Food Services. Other major industries of employment included Advertising Services 4.0%, Legal and Accounting Services 3.6%, Auxiliary Finance and Investment Services 3.5% and Computer System Design and Related Services 3.2%.

The median weekly personal income for people aged 15 years and over in Bondi Beach was \$1,050.

In Bondi Beach, of people aged 15 years and over, 67.2% did unpaid domestic work in the week before the Census. During the two weeks before the Census, 17.5% provided care for children and 6.3% assisted family members or others due to a disability, long term illness or problems related to old age. In the year before the Census, 15.9% of people did voluntary work through an organisation or a group.

Of people who did unpaid domestic work in the week before the Census in Bondi Beach (State Suburbs), 22.1% worked 5 to 14 hours, 5.4% worked 15 to 29 hours and 3.8% worked 30 hours or more.

Dwellings — dwelling structure

In Bondi Beach, 87.1% of private dwellings were occupied and 12.9% were unoccupied.

Of occupied private dwellings in Bondi Beach, 5.5% were separate houses, 12.5% were semi-detached, row or terrace houses, townhouses etc, 81.1% were flats, units or apartments and 0.8% were other dwellings.

Of occupied private dwellings in Bondi Beach, 17.2% were owned outright, 19.0% were owned with a mortgage and 60.1% were rented.

In Bondi Beach, of all households, 48.1% were family households, 35.3% were single person households and 16.7% were group households.

In Bondi Beach, 14.5% of households had a weekly household income of less than \$600 and 22.0% of households had a weekly income of more than \$3,000.
